This year's inclusive price for land and air is \$2,750 per person. \$1,000 per person by March 1 will hold your reservation. The balance is due by June 10, 2018.

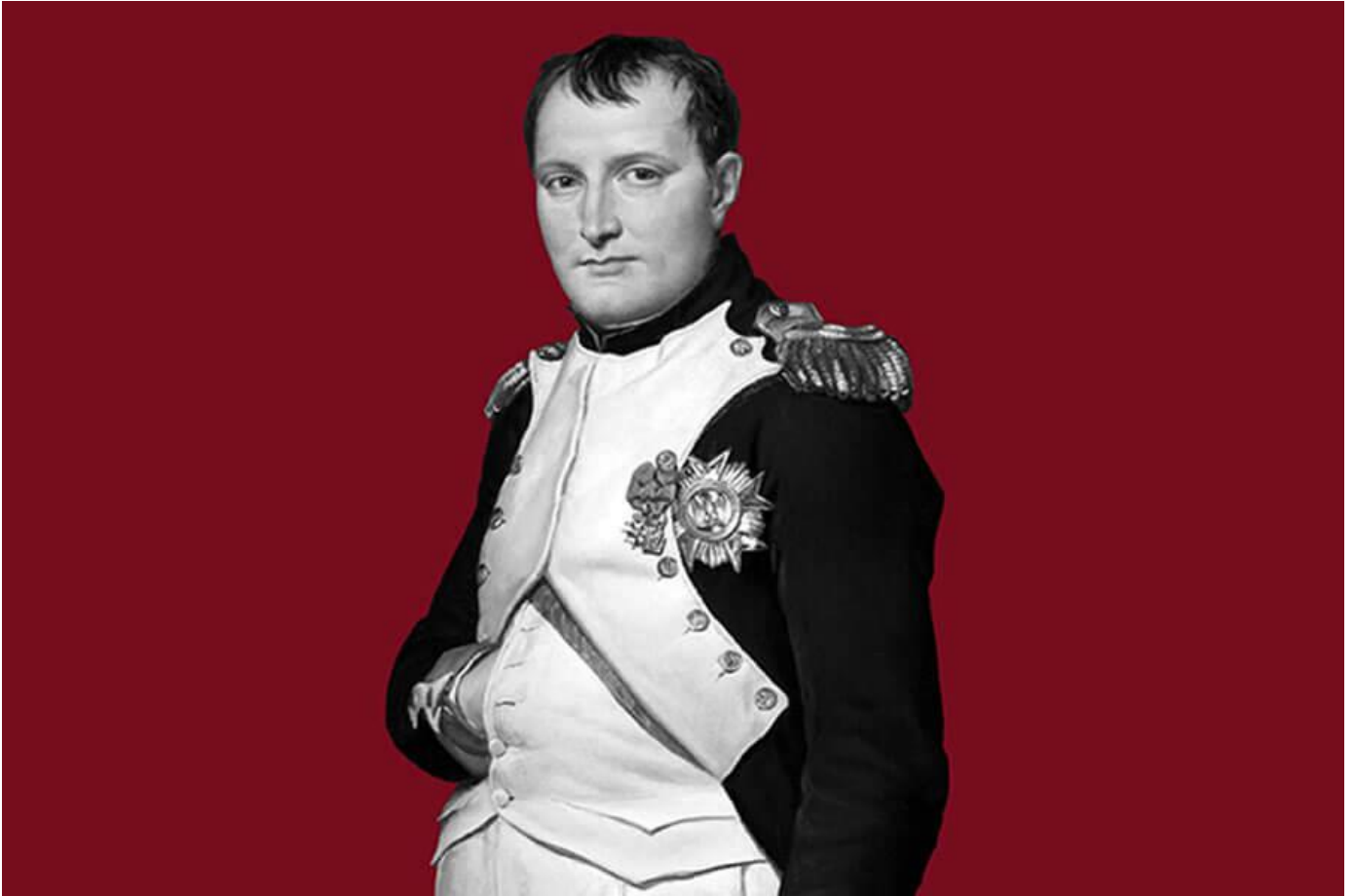
